Attached is a Lantern Template for children to decorate & make a Lantern Instructions:

- 1. Fold the Template in half at the dotted lines then decorate both sides.
- 2. The side not decorated, write your full name (this is the inside of your lantern)
- 3. After decorating, at the fold, <u>cut at the solid lines to the end of the solid lines</u> **not to the end of the paper**
- 5. Use tape or staple the 2 ends together (or we can do it for you)
- 6. Turn your Lantern in at a **Lantern Drop-Off box** located at: The Temple of Kwan Tai, FBUSD or MUSD front office, CV Starr or the Mendocino Community Center.
